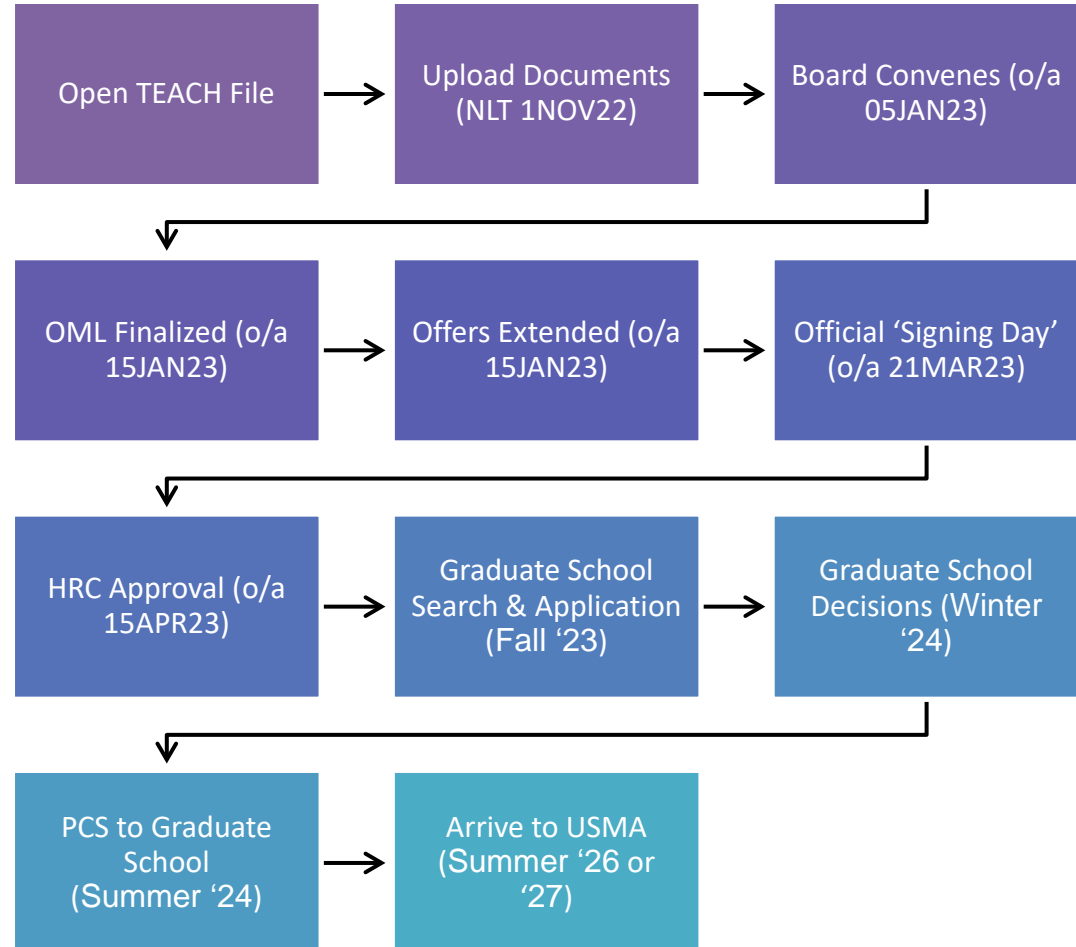

  - Career Satisfaction Program Information (if applicable)
  - Degrees Completed and Transcripts
  - GRE/GMAT Score Scores and Report
  - Publications (if applicable)
  - Officer Evaluation Reports (OERs)
  - Letters of Recommendation (LORs)
  - Officer Record Brief (ORB)
  - Personal Photo, if desired
  - Special Considerations (MACP, EFMP, etc.)
- DSE-specific TEACH Application Materials
  - Department Essay Questions (3x)
  - CV or Resume (optional)
  - APFT Scores (optional)
  - Desired Board Year
